The main drivers of the HIV epidemic are influenced by a wide range of gender inequalities. Three major factors – all interconnected – can be identified that place gender issues at the core of the HIV/AIDS pandemic in Africa: 1) risk and vulnerability to HIV/AIDS are substantially different for men and for women 2) the impact of HIV/AIDS differs markedly along gender lines, and 3) tackling the AIDS pandemic is fundamentally about behaviour change, aimed at effecting a “ transformation ” of gender relations and roles in Africa1.

Addressing gender inequalities in HIV/AIDS programming can be done in at least two ways: a) through specific interventions that promote gender equality in sectors such as health, education, and legal affairs; or, b) by integrating gender into standard HIV/AIDS interventions such as PMTCT, HIV testing and counselling, and health systems strengthening.

BACKGROUND: The Declaration of Commitment of the United Nations General Assembly Special Session on HIV/AIDS (UNGASS), in 2001, sets out several policy and programmatic commitments that pertain to women and the gender aspects of the HIV epidemic. Addressing gender inequalities is central to improving the sexual and reproductive health outcomes and more broadly, the wellbeing of women living with HIV. Even as HIV prevention, treatment and care services for women living with HIV are being expanded and bringing many benefits, the context of gender inequalities is undermining these efforts.

Evaluations show that lack of ownership of gender equality goals and strategies is a key obstacle to addressing gender issues in developmen t activities. Ownership of obj ectives and approaches is more likely to be shared if there is a clear link to policies and commitments that the partner has already made on equality for women.
