Inpatient management revolves around the supportive management of the most common complications of severe COVID-19: pneumonia, hypoxemic respiratory failure/ARDS, sepsis and septic shock, cardiomyopathy and arrhythmia, acute kidney injury, and complications from prolonged hospitalization, including secondary bacterial infections, thromboembolism, gastrointestinal bleeding, and critical illness polyneuropathy/myopathy. 1,4-6,14,36,38,70-73

In order to achieve the best possible outcomes while decreasing the risk of undetected injuries, the management of trauma patients requires a highly systematic approach. Prehospital trauma care involves first aid and basic life support administered by emergency services personnel. In the hospital setting, the treatment of trauma patients is traditionally divided into primary (Advanced Trauma Life Support), secondary, and tertiary surveys.

Severely agitated patients. In the severely agitated patient the history and physical exam are more limited, so it is important to be organized in your approach. A) First few minutes. 1. Place the patient in a resuscitation room and apply cardiorespiratory monitoring, capnography and oximetry. 2. Place 1-2 large bore IV lines. 3. Assess for and start to treat:
