### Journalism: Reporting on the Courts

Contemporaneous reporting of a court case. Contemporaneous is a long word, but it means the next issue of the newspaper or the next news bulletin. In some legal systems, such as Britain, as long as you publish or broadcast a court report contemporaneously, you will have a special kind of protection from privilege (called absolute privilege). In this case, your report only has to be fair and accurate; it does not matter whether or not it was actuated by malice.

The general rule is that the administration of justice must be done in public. The public and the media have the right to attend all court hearings and the media is able to report those proceedings fully and contemporaneously. Any restriction on these usual rules will be exceptional. It must be based on necessity.
