Each regional tournament is run according to the current Science Olympiad rules. Most regional tournaments have competitions for both divisions B and C that run concurrently, but some regionals have separate tournaments and locations ...

Science Olympiad - Team Registration and Fees

A Science Olympiad team consists of up to 15 students, representing a single school. A team may have alternates, but only a maximum of 15 students may compete in the scoring events on tournament day. Alternates may compete in any trial events offered at tournaments.
