Lifts provided for use by workers in workplaces are subject to the Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Regulations (LOLER). However, in most cases lifting equipment which is not provided for, or used by, people at work will not be subject to either LOLER or PUWER. But businesses providing this equipment will have responsibilities for its safety.

Positioning the scissor lift to avoid crushing or electrocution hazards is important for safe use. Crushing hazards are present in workplaces using scissor lifts and may expose workers nearby, even those not working on the scissor lift. When pressure is applied to the outside of the lowest set of supports through hydraulic, pneumatic or mechanical means, the crossing supports 'lengthen' to raise the platform.
