Investment duties Trustees have wide investment powers through the Trustee Act 2000 (E&W), Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and Trustee Act (Northern Ireland) 2001. This means that unless the trust deed restricts the type of investment, they are able to invest in any type of asset.

What duties and responsibilities do trustees have?

The law requires that trustees have knowledge and understanding of (among other things) the law relating to pensions and trusts, as well as the principles relating to the funding of pension schemes and the investment of scheme assets. The law also requires you to be familiar with certain scheme documents including the trust deed and rules, the statement of investment principles and the ...
